SEND Review Meetings



Parents evening took place on Tuesday 28^h November. At this meeting, your child's **first SEND review** for this school year would have taken place. Your child's class teacher will have discussed your child's provision map, reviewing, and assessing (**Review and Assess**) your child's progress from the beginning of the Autumn Term.

How BEAM works:

There is no booking required to use our services. However, you must be registered with us. You can register with Beam through our website or register with us when you arrive.

You must also be registered with a GP in Shropshire or Telford & Wrekin.

You only have to register with us once. If you have already registered with us online or have registered with us when using our service before, you do not need to re-register.

Upon arrival, you will be greeted by a friendly member of our team who will sign you in. Then, a practitioner will see you as soon as they are available.

Please note: Young people age 14+ can register and use our service independently.

Young people age 13 or under will need a parent/carer to register on their behalf and to use our service.

Here at Telford Children's Autism Hub we offer a variety of support for our families, including weekly Coffee & Chat peer support for our parents and carers every Monday during term time. This provides time for you to exhale and relax with a cuppa and good conversation with people who truly understand the journey you are on.

We also run monthly family sessions for primary aged children on the 3rd Tuesday of the month and our DUGOUT youth group for our young people aged 11 to 18 years, on the 1st Thursday of the month (term time only). Parents and carers are invited too!. These sessions are filled with fun activities and creative art to allow you to spend quality time with your child away from the hum drum of life and build friendships with other families in our hub.

During the school holidays we offer additional fun activity sessions.
